Registering for Free-School Meals (Pupil Premium)

For families who are on lower income, the Government gives their children's school extra money and it also gives the children free school meals. This is called Pupil Premium money. This money makes a real difference to our school. It helps us pay for a Teaching Assistant in every class every morning of the

week. It also helps us to run catch-up groups for children who need it.

Those children registered for Free School Meal (Pupil Premium) can also claim financial support from the school for trips, uniform, music lessons, and other activities.

Children in Reception, Year One and Year Two receive free school meals but this alone does not make the Government give us Pupil Premium money. For this to be paid, parents have to register on-line using the link below. It is quick, confidential and benefits your child and other children in the school enormously.

We would like to receive donations of goodquality pre-loved toys in advance that can be given to Lucy or Ruth in the school's office. The toys


will be sold to new owners at small prices. The point of the sale is help our local families budget for Christmas.
