You are not allowed to take your child out of school for holidays!



Government guidance about pupil absence during school time comes into force from 1st September 2022. This means that pupils are not permitted to miss school due to holidays taken during term time. (If there are exceptional circumstances, then these will be considered between the Governors and the Head Teacher and this must be applied for in advance through the school office). Cheaper holidays available in term-time are not deemed to be exceptional circumstances. Unauthorised holidays taken will be referred to Warwickshire Attendance Service and may result in a fine being issued.

The school's Attendance Policy for the new school year is attached to this newsletter. It sets out expectations for attendance, being on time for school, medical appointments and absence during school term time. Please could you take time to read this so you understand the school's strategy to keep all of our children in school to maximise their learning opportunities.





Please label all items your child brings into school. Thank you.

Please label everything your child brings to school. This includes uniform, PE kit, pencil case, bag, coat, shoes... yes, everything, please!

Any named item will be returned to your child if they are mislaid. Any un-named item will most probably end up being lost.

Naming items helps your child because:

- They will not worry because mislaid items will be returned to them.
- They will have everything with them that they need to learn and enjoy school.

Naming items helps parents because:

- Lost unforms are an unnecessary expense.
- Named items will come back to your child.

Naming items helps teachers and staff because:

• Searching for lost items for children takes the staff away from supporting children with their learning and wellbeing.

Order Lunches On-Line



From the start of the new term (next week), all lunches will be ordered by parents at home on ParentPay. This will be done weekly in advance. Lunch orders for the week will need to be submitted on ParentPay by 8am on the Monday morning, each week. For those children in Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and those with Free School Meal entitlement, you should simply pre-order your child's meal choices. For those children who wish to have a school dinner and pay for their meals, these should be paid for at the time of ordering, please.

Once you have a Parent Pay Account, pre-ordering your child's lunch choice is really easy. To order your child's lunch, please login to your ParentPay account, and select the child you are ordering lunch for. Then go to Book Meals and Places - Make Bookings - and select the Make or View bookings button. This will take you to the menu for the week. To select a meal, click on the appropriate box and the meal you have chosen will be highlighted in green. When you have made all your choices, you can click on Confirm Bookings and the choices will be saved.

If you experience problems with your ParentPay login, please let Ruth Shippey in the office know and she will look into this for you.

New parents will receive their login for ParentPay on 5th September from Mrs. Shippey in the school office, before their children start but please do contact her if you experience any difficulties.
